COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

ESSENTIAL GRAMMAR AND BUILDING SENTENCES: An overview of basic grammatical concepts, vocabulary and sentence structure, giving students a foundational introduction to the way isiXhosa operates. *Entry requirements: Completion of Beginner Course 1.*

BEGINNER COURSE 1 – Essential Social IsiXhosa: Carefully paced so that by the end, you are able to have a full conversation, from greetings and introductions to small talk and farewells. *Entry requirements: Open to all.*

BEGINNER COURSE 2 – Essential Practical IsiXhosa: Equips you with language for everyday situations and environments, such as at the garage and shops, when offering hospitality, speaking about the weather and more. *Entry requirements: Completion of Beginner Course 1 (or equivalent knowledge). If unsure, ask us for an email test.*

BEGINNER COURSE 3 – Extending Social IsiXhosa: Includes dialogues based on feelings, health, special occasions and expressing your opinion, with relevant vocabulary, grammatical structures and idiomatic phrases introduced. *Entry requirements: Completion of Beginner Course 1 (or equivalent knowledge) and preferably Beginner Course 2. If unsure, ask us for an email test.*
